Bug Fixes

- Dr First
 - Ever since RCopia4, UnifiMD has been more susceptible to browser crashes. We have added better error handling to allow UnifiMD to run unaffected by Browser errors related to Rcopia.
 - Last call date and time are now reporting correctly in the Dr First API Logs
- Spelling and labels
 - The word Referred in the Clinical Encounters Window.
 - The word Privilege in the Emergency Access Prompt.
 - Labs Tab now reads Lab Results
 - Patient First and Last name in Chart Summary now display correctly
- Clinical Encounter - Location Column added for sorting purposes
- Notes
 - Toolbar customization will now save as expected
 - Font size and type will remember your last selection
- Notes/Guides/Letters
 - Signed by User Time Stamp will now display at the end of the note when signing.
 - Notes Header vs User Preference Header
 - When a user adds a custom header to a Note Guide, then the User Preference Header/Footer settings will be ignored. If the guide has no header, then User Preferences will function.
- Reports
 - If a lab report is on the Historical tab of the patients' chart, it will no longer display on the Unreviewed Labs Report

New Features

- Notes – History Button - Up/Down buttons are now present to let the chooser create a custom order to insert data into the note.
- Notes/Guides/Letters
 - Toolbar customization will automatically open when starting a new guide, note or letter if a user previously, accidentally removed all toolbar options
- Faxing
 - When composing a new fax, you can now
 - Attach a Patient
 - Choose fax recipients based on the patients Associations tab in demographics
 - Available when faxing from Tools, Notes and Letters
 - If a patient does not have an association, that option will be grey
 - Select files from the patient's chart

- Multiple files will be combined into a single PDF and send in a single fax.
- Cover sheet Note field added
- Preview button added
- Edit and Resend will now make a copy of the selected fax and create a new job, so the history of both attempts can be recorded
- Core Program
 - The prompt for new versions is now visually more alarming. It features a stop sign, more specific warnings and recommendations about performing the update and a second confirmation before allowing a user to run updates.
 - Requires .Net Framework 4.6 or Higher
 - Upgraded to DevExpress 18.2 for optimized WinForms and security
 - The following tables are being compressed to reduce database size and disk usage

 - DrFirst_RcopiaErrorLog
 - DrFirst_RequestLog
- Dr First
 - Mobile Phone Number is now included in the Send Patient API Call.
 - The Embedded Browser is now Chromium based instead of Internet Explorer
 - Clear Cache added to Dr First > Website
- Medications added manually in UnifiMD
 - Medication type now defaults to current
 - Medication fields reorganized
- Messaging
 - When sending a new message, the Send To will now default to Users
