Bug Fixes

- Removed Signed column in Letters tab
- Unsigned Notes totals now calculates correctly
- Last Reviewed by name in medications getting cut off
- Family History adopted check mark will save automatically when checked. It will also cause the data indicator light to turn green
- Inactive provider will no longer show in Medications, Text Labs, and Orders
- Unhandled Exception when archiving patients
- Fixed bug where users could not delete row Custom Fields rows in insurance companies
- Fixed bug where user could not use Guides->Clinical Assessment->System->Copy from existing

New Features

- To reduce memory usage in the application, the Notes column in the progress note table is compressed with GZip and encoded in Base64. This is not a human readable file. If any third party extracts this data out of the database, they will need this information to convert to human readable
- Highlighted text should now appear white against a royal blue background allowing users to read it easier. Windows Settings and UnifiMD Skins may affect this.
- When entering Vitals, Inhaled Oxygen will not be selected by default. It can be turned back on in Configurations > Defaults
- Reason for Deleting text will no longer be required if Wrong Chart is selected
- Order Forms diagnosis selection has been modified. Instead of a multi select, there are individual fields for multiple diagnosis codes. This will allow printing of Diagnosis codes on the order form
- In Configuration > Chart Layouts, the Messaging tab and Chart Capture button can now be hidden
- Unsigned Lab totals in the review bin will now total labs based on lab headers, not details.
- When adding Expressions to a Note Guide, there is now a Quick Add button
- HM Items will now display the check marks of linked chart data correctly when editing
- Medications Tab data indicator lights will now light up when No Current Medications is checked
- When using the Medication History Button, Sign and Cosign will no longer appear in the note
- Registration Updates and Update Settings
 - A new database will automatically be created on the SQL Server instance that your practice list is configured for – DB Name: UnifiMDShare
 - With a new installation, registration will automatically be saved to this database
 - With an existing installation once the update is installed, UnifiMD will first look to the database for registration information. If it is missing, it will look to C:\ProgramData\IsolatedStorage.
 - To permanently set the update settings to the shared database, simply click Help > Update Settings and click OK

- Registration data will automatically be moved to the shared database from the first PC/Server that launches UnifiMD.
- Outside PCP now maps correctly from Lytec in Demographics (Verify mapping first)
- When using New Problem Macro – Required field warning resolved
- Social History Columns Labels description changed to identify data correctly
- Patient filter set to show inactive by default when archiving patients
- Audit Trail entries added for Adopted in Family History
