Bug Fixes

- General Performance Enhancements have been made to improve performance where heavy customizations are used and stored on a network share.
- Vitals weight will now convert to metric and back correctly
- Users will now be able to view multimedia attachments in read only mode if another user is in that patient's chart
- Care Plan data will save correctly when entering multiple lines of data
- Unsigned labs totals in the menu bar will now reflect the correct number of labs
- Users can now delete message guides

New Features

Patients

- Patient Lookup - When the patient lookup screen loads, the cursor will default to the name field, so you can start typing without clicking first
- Patient Messaging – “Hide deleted” filter added to bottom of the patient messaging tab in the patient's chart
- Immunization tab renamed to Immunizations/Injections
- You can now open a patient chart by using the arrow keys to highlight a patient and the Enter key to open the selected chart.
- Reviewed button added to the following Chart tabs. When clicked, the current user and a date/time stamp will be recorded
 - Family History
 - Social History
 - Past Medical History

Vitals

- New fields added. Used primarily for pediatrics and required for upcoming CURES Act certification, these fields are for the storage of percentile values.
 - BMI %
 - Head Circumference %
 - Weight %

Patient Chart – Messages Tab

- The indicator light will light up as follows
 - Red – If there are unread messages
 - Green – If there are any messages read or unread
 - Not visible – If there are no messages at all

Print Full Chart

- Users can now specify a date range or All to filter data

- Specific Files can now be selected
- The report outputs as a single job
- Pages can be resorted

Custom Shortcuts

- A new Menu Bar Item named Custom has been added. You can now set up shortcuts to launch external applications while in UnifiMD.
 - Shortcuts must be placed in a network share with appropriate permissions for all users to be able to access
 - Users that access the shortcut must have the native application installed locally to view the files

Appointment Dashboard Data

- The following columns have been added to the column chooser on the Dashboard Appointment window:
 - Patient Group 1 Description
 - Patient Group 2 Description
 - Primary Insurance Name
 - Primary Copay
 - Interpreter Needed Y/N
 - Preferred Contact

Printing Medications now has the following option

- Print All
- Print All Current
- Print All Ineffective
- Print All Historical
- Print Selected

Messaging

- A Status message will now indicate whether a message has been replied to or forwarded.
- Users can right click to flag or unflag a message to add or remove a visual indicator to that message in their inbox
- Folders can be added to the inbox, to allow users to move messages for better organization.

Other

- Data entered via the Quick Add In buttons will now auto refresh so they will display without needing to reload the lookup window
- Notes codes can now be saved using the F3 button
- Under Guides > Lab Guides > Lab Results > Lab Names. The text YYY/MM has been added to the Columns for From Age and To Age to visually remind users of correct format.
- Force Password Resets at Next Login check mark has been added to the main user's screen
- Provider/Physician filter columns added to unreviewed labs.
