Bug Fixes

- Issues with sync service not crossing new patients over from Lytec to UnifiMD have been fixed
- The notification area fax count now shows the same number for each user
- Faxing multiple pages is no longer missing a page break
- The history placeholder in Message Guides has been fixed
- The secondary note field line for attributes is now pulling into progress notes accurately
- Text box on the left of the patient chart no longer consolidates text when you exit the screen and return
- Misspellings under User Configuration have been corrected
- Progress notes now have appropriate page breaks and numbering if multiples are sent in one fax
- Sorting of lookup screens is now recalling the sorting order per user, it was broken in last release
- When recording lab results the received date no longer reverts to today when saving
- When attempting to setup User Profile Storage settings to a shared server, the "Please select a folder in a shared server" error is no longer occurring
- Patient Sex is now populating un XVU messages to immunization registries
- If you read a message in the Updox portal itself, once marked read it was not coming into UnifiMD, those messages will now come into UnifiMD even if viewed in the Updox portal first
- Patient image was not saving when adding to a chart, this has been fixed
- Updox Forms sent to the office from patients were coming into UnifiMD as a blank white pdf, this has been corrected
- When opening the DrFirst Problem list area directly from a patient's chart or from the history button in their Note, the system would sometimes not allow you to search for a diagnosis code without first going to the main patient screen, this has been fixed.

New Features

- Added "sister" and "manager" as relationship options for contacts in demographics
- The unsigned labs notification count now includes text labs as well
- Added an "Apply New" button to family history member area
- Added a display of characters remaining to clinical assessments note box to avoid an error when too many characters are entered into the field (1,500)
- In chart summary report and full chart report, changed the label "modified date" to read just "Date"
- Print layout was created to allow you to print one or more dates of vitals (using CTRL or SHIFT keys to select multiple rows)
- Column changes made to layout when inserting vitals from history
- Ability to cosign notes added:
 - In "Save & Sign" window a check box has been added to note a co-signature is required

- New status shown in unsigned notes and notes tab of chart called “Cosign”
 - New button added to notes section called “Save & Cosign” for second provider to sign
 - After co-signed status will change to “Signed”
 - New column in unsigned notes window called Cosign Provider to display who that is
- Ability to default a cosigning provider added:
 - Under User Preferences, “Note, Lab, text Lab Signatures” tab, new area called “Default Cosign Provider”
 - Check this box and choose a specific provider to default on any notes signed by this user.
- The text lab condition button has new columns added to improve mapping abilities on incoming results interfaces and gives the user less manual mapping to perform
- A postural tab has been added the vitals section that gives end users the ability to view and compare postural readings in one screen – this is a Read Only tab, information is still added in the typical fashion
- A new print layout has been created to view postural tab summary view
- A default fax cover sheet has been created and users can default the format they want to default under user preferences
- The message guide screen has been rearranged and cleaned up with unnecessary lines removed when making a new message guide
- Fax inbox changes:
 - Incoming faxes show as bold
 - 3 action columns have been added that are automatically used and time stamped when performed (forwarded, copied to patient, printed)
 - Once one action has been completed the fax is no longer shown in bold
 - Date filter at the bottom left now defaults to showing last 14 days instead of just today
- Under practice, preferences, access rules tab, there is now a section to set password expiration policies
- When entering a new past illness or surgery, the date and age fields have been separated and work independent of each other. The date field here is now a free type field to allow typing “March 2017” as an example when exact date is unknown
- Under notifications, the link for Refill Requests now brings you to the Renewals from the pharmacy screen in DrFirst that need to be processed
- Under notifications, a new link has been added for Pending Scripts that brings you to the Pending Rx screen in DrFirst of prescriptions not yet sent to the pharmacy
- Changes to CCDA exports to HIE:
 - New tab created in practice settings called HIE allowing for creation of multiple paths to store CCDA’s for HIE’s to pick them up from
 - Auto export check box in setup means any time a Clinical summary is generated it will default to sending to that HIE
 - When you generate a clinical encounter you can add, remove or change the HIE from the field at the bottom of the screen (multi select is allowed)
