



## Release Notes Version UnifiMD 2.0.61.17

\*\* There was a mandated deadline for all certified EMRs to update the format of exported CCDAs to the new USCDI Version 3.1 by December 31, 2025. This requirement initially demanded the full focus of our development efforts for the quarterly release. However, due to the government shutdown and EMRs' inability to access the certification testing tools during that period, the deadline was extended by 60 days. As a result, the focus of the 2025 fourth-quarter update shifted to delivering a concise but meaningful set of enhancements requested by end users. The CCDA update will now be delivered as part of the first-quarter 2026 release. \*\*

### **New features/enhancements:**

#### General

- Throughout the program, any tabs, windows, screens that have a grid appearance now have alternating gray and white rows providing better readability for users.

#### Labs

- In unsigned labs, the patient and report name at the top of the selected lab results section will appear in bold to clearly see which line you have selected
- Inside the lab results tab of a chart, when grouped by Report Name, the Report "header row" will be in a darker shade of gray with bolded relevant information. This allows the user to view things more clearly on this tab.
- Ranges are now available in the Lab Results tab to be added under Column Chooser so you can view the standard ranges without having to open the individual result to find that information.
- For new users created in the system moving forward, the column headers for unsigned labs, unsigned text labs, lab results and patient lab results have been standardized to a more common format, to avoid the need to manually adjust them for each new user created.

#### Faxing

- Double clicking on a fax in the fax tool now opens the View Fax window. Users can still highlight it and click view but double clicking also works.
- A Print button has been added inside the PDF viewer to allow printing from within the preview instead of needing to close out to print.

#### Care Plan Rework

- Changes in the Template Default area for set up have been made to allow more ways of using Care Plans

- The layout of the Care Plans screen has changed, providing more space and a way to set review dates per plan.
- The History Placeholder for Care Plans also pulls information into the note in a cleaner way

#### Flow Charts rework

- To and from filter dates can be used to view only historical data columns in that range. Note that users can leave one end open on the filter.
- The column width has been set so that as more columns are added to the viewable area, the columns do not shrink down narrower, instead a scroll bar appears
- The far-left column is locked so when scrolling left to right it does not disappear from view.
- The column order is now set in date order with the most recent date on the left
  - If the item is a medication, the strength will show in the field.
  - If the item is a lab result, the result value will show in the field.
  - If the item is an allergy, the word Yes will display if they have that allergy.
- Immunizations has been added as an item that can be added to a Flow Chart Guide.

## **Bug fixes:**

#### General

- The "show inactive" checkbox in search windows since the last update was requiring the user to turn it off and on a few times for it to filter properly. It is now behaving properly.

#### Labs

- With a certain workflow in Unsigned Text Labs, if you pinned the header to hidden and used the previous/next arrows to flip to the previous or next patient, one area kept the name of the prior patient displaying. This has been corrected.
- The secondary scroll bar inside of lab results when there are a lot on the screen was behaving erratically and now scrolls properly. If the user wants to use the scroll wheel on the mouse, you must click somewhere in the section you want to make the scroll wheel control (standard windows behavior)

#### Scanning

- When trying to assign a scan to a user for signing off on while in the scanning screen, the "assign to" was not sticking and the user had to manually assign the scan after saving it. This has been corrected and the user can assign it to someone while in the scanning window
- The bug from the last update that caused scanning to freeze inside UnifiMD has been corrected and freezing is no longer occurring

#### Faxing

- The Print button at the top of the fax tool was printing a transmission page instead of the fax. This has been corrected and after a prompt of which printer you wish to use, this method of printing will print the fax without previewing it.
